

# Dependent Sections

This feature saves tremendous time at the beginning of the year and is invaluable when a student arrives later in the school year. They automatically get enrolled in all the classes they need in one step.

The function is often used by elementary schools where students take a set of classes. Dependent sections indicate that if a student is registered in one class, he or she must also get enrolled in the dependent class(es). Eg. Student enrolled in Homeroom is automatically enrolled in Science, Math, Social Studies, Language, Music, Phys Ed, Art

School > School Setup > Sections

Select the section which you want to add the dependent sections to, by clicking on the section number.

## HR Homeroom

In the Dependent Section field, enter all the sections (course.section format) that the selected students must also be enrolled in.

Dependent Sections  
(course.section, course.section, etc.)

5LA.WP5CA,5MA.WP5  
CA,5SS.WP5CA,5SC.

Separate sections numbers with a comma and **NO** spaces

For example:

5LA.WP5CA,5MA.WP5CA,5SS.WP5CA,5SC.WP5CA,5MU.WP5CA,5PE.WP5CA,5ART.WP5CA,HR.WP5CAPM  
(no spaces between comma and next course)

**Tip**—The Dependent Section box is very small and does not expand in Internet Explorer but does in Chrome. I find it is easier to enter all of the course.section info in a Word, Excel or Notepad document and then copy and paste it into the Dependent Sections box. It's much easier to see errors before you put the info into this box.
